14 (2)NOTIFICATION \mathbf{OF} TERMINATIONS NOT 15 BASED ON PERFORMANCE.—Subject to the avail-16 ability of appropriations, the Secretary or the Assist-17 ant Secretary shall not reduce the number of full-18 time equivalent positions in the Office of Space 19 Commerce or the Bureau of Space Commerce for 20 any reason other than performance without prior no-21 tification to the Committee on Commerce, Science, 22 and Transportation of the Senate and the Com-23 mittee on Science, Space, and Technology of the 24 House of Representatives.
