Viz:

1 Beginning on page 10, strike line 23 and all that fol-
2 lows through page 11, line 4, and insert the following:

3 (3) WAIVER PROCESS FOR DENIED CREDEN-
4 TIALS.—Notwithstanding section 44936(b) of title
5 49, United States Code, in revising the regulations
6 under paragraph (1) of this subsection, the Adminis-
7 trator shall—

8 (A) ensure there exists or is developed a
9 waiver process for approving the issuance of
10 credentials for unescorted access to the SIDA,
11 for an individual found to be otherwise ineli-
12 gible for such credentials; and

1 (B) consider, as appropriate and prac-
2 ticable—

3 (i) the circumstances of any disquali-
4 fying act or offense, restitution made by
5 the individual, Federal and State mitiga-
6 tion remedies, and other factors from
7 which it may be concluded that the indi-
8 vidual does not pose a terrorism risk or a
9 risk to aviation security warranting denial
10 of the credential; and

11 (ii) the elements of the appeals and
12 waiver process established under section
13 70105(e) of title 46, United States Code.
