Viz:

1 On page 4, strike lines 4 through 13, and insert the  
2 following:

3 **SEC. 4. INSPECTOR GENERAL AUDIT.**

4 (a) AUDIT.—Not later than 60 days after the date  
5 of the enactment of this Act, the Inspector General shall  
6 analyze the data and methods that the Assistant Secretary  
7 uses to identify Office of Inspection employees of the Ad-  
8 ministration who meet the requirements of sections  
9 8331(20), 8401(17), and 5545a of title 5, United States  
10 Code, and provide the relevant findings to the Assistant

1 Secretary, including a finding on whether the data and  
2 methods are adequate and valid.

3 On page 4, line 16, strike “may” and insert “shall”.

4 On page 5, beginning on line 13, strike “only” and  
5 all that follows through “Code,” on line 15, and insert  
6 “only those Office of Inspection employees of the Adminis-  
7 tration who meet the requirements of sections 8331(20),  
8 8401(17), and 5545a of title 5, United States Code,”.

9 On page 6, line 17, insert “and other premium” after  
10 “availability”.

11 On page 7, line 3, strike “any”.
