1 At the end of part II of subtitle A of title II, insert  
2 the following:

3 **SEC. 2142. UNMANNED AIRCRAFT SYSTEMS IN RESTRICTED**  
4 **BUILDINGS OR GROUNDS.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 448, as amended by sec-  
6 tion 2141 of this Act, is further amended by inserting  
7 after section 44815 the following:

8 **“§ 44816. Unmanned Aircraft Systems in Restricted**  
9 **Buildings or Grounds**

10 “(a) IN GENERAL.—It shall be unlawful to knowingly  
11 operate an unmanned aircraft system with the intent for

1 such unmanned aircraft system to enter or operate within  
2 or above a restricted building or grounds (as defined in  
3 section 1752 of title 18) and to impede or disrupt the or-  
4 derly conduct of Government business or official functions.

5 “(b) PENALTY.—Any person who violates subsection  
6 (a) shall be—

7 “(1) fined under title 18, imprisoned for not  
8 more than 10 years, or both, if—

9 “(A) a deadly or dangerous weapon or fire-  
10 arm is affixed to the unmanned aircraft system;  
11 or

12 “(B) the offense results in significant bod-  
13 ily injury, as defined in section 2118 of title 18;  
14 or

15 “(2) fined under title 18, imprisoned for not  
16 more than 1 year, or both, in any other case.”.

17 (b) TABLE OF CONTENTS.—The table of contents for  
18 chapter 448, as added by section 2121 of this Act, is fur-  
19 ther amended by inserting after the item relating to sec-  
20 tion 44815 the following:

“44816. Unmanned aircraft systems in restricted buildings or grounds.”.
