3 **SEC. 2242. PORTABILITY OF REPAIRMAN CERTIFICATES.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Administrator of the Federal
5 Aviation Administration shall assign to the Aviation Rule-
6 making Advisory Committee the task of making rec-
7 ommendations with respect to the regulatory and policy
8 changes necessary to allow a repairman certificate issued
9 under section 65.101 of title 14, Code of Federal Regula-
10 tions, to be portable from one employing certificate holder
11 to another.

12 (b) ACTION BASED ON RECOMMENDATIONS.—Not
13 later than one year after receiving recommendations under
14 subsection (a), the Administrator shall take such action
15 as the Administrator considers appropriate with respect
16 to those recommendations.

17 **SEC. 2243. AVIATION MAINTENANCE WORKFORCE DEVEL-**
18 **OPMENT PILOT PROGRAM.**

19 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Administrator of the Federal
20 Aviation Administration may carry out a pilot program to
21 provide grants for eligible projects to support the edu-
22 cation and recruitment of aviation maintenance technical
23 workers and the development of the aviation maintenance
