AMENDMENTS intended to be proposed by Mr. MARKEY

Viz:

1 In section 102(b)(3), strike “civilian”.

2 In section 102(b)(4), strike “and the National Quan-
3 tum Information Science Research Centers established
4 under section 402(a)” and insert “, the collaborative ven-
5 tures or consortia established under section 201(a), and
6 centers or consortia established by other agencies partici-
7 pating in the Program”.

8 At the appropriate place in section 103(d), insert the
9 following:

1 () propose a coordinated interagency budget
2 for the Program to the Office of Management and
3 Budget to ensure the maintenance of a balanced
4 quantum information science research portfolio and
5 an appropriate level of research effort;

6 In section 103(f), strike "REPORTS" and insert
7 "SUBMITTAL OF STRATEGIC PLANS".

8 In section 103, at the end, add the following:

9 (g) ANNUAL PROGRAM BUDGET REPORT.—

10 (1) IN GENERAL.—Each year, concurrent with
11 the annual budget request submitted by the Presi-
12 dent to Congress under section 1105 of title 31,
13 United States Code, the Chairs of the Subcommittee
14 shall submit to the Committee on Commerce,
15 Science, and Transportation of the Senate, the Com-
16 mittee on Science, Space, and Technology of the
17 House of Representatives, and such other commit-
18 tees of Congress as may be appropriate a report on
19 the budget for the Program.

20 (2) CONTENTS.—Each report submitted under
21 paragraph (1) shall include the following:

1 (A) The budget of the Program for the
2 current fiscal year, for each agency that partici-
3 pates in the Program.

4 (B) The budget proposed for the Program
5 for the next fiscal year, for each agency that
6 participates in the Program.

7 (C) An analysis of the progress made to-
8 ward achieving the goals and priorities estab-
9 lished for the Program.
