- 1 At the end of title V, add the following:
- 2 **SEC. 5 ____ . DRUG-IMPAIRED DRIVING DATA COLLECTION.**
- 3 Not later than 2 years after the date of enactment
- 4 of this Act, the Secretary, in consultation with the heads
- 5 of appropriate Federal agencies, State highway safety of-
- 6 fices, State toxicologists, traffic safety advocates, and
- 7 other interested parties, shall submit to the Committee on
- 8 Commerce, Science, and Transportation of the Senate and
- 9 the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure of
- 10 the House of Representatives a report that, in accordance
- 11 with the document entitled "Recommendations for Toxi-

1 ological Investigations of Drug-Impaired Driving and
2 Motor Vehicle Fatalities—2017 Update” (and subsequent
3 updates to that document)—

4 (1) identifies any barriers that States encounter
5 in submitting alcohol and drug toxicology results to
6 the Fatality Analysis Reporting System;

7 (2) provides recommendations on how to ad-
8 dress the barriers identified pursuant to paragraph
9 (1); and

10 (3) describes steps that the Secretary, acting
11 through the Administrator of the National Highway
12 Traffic Safety Administration, will take to assist
13 States in improving—

14 (A) toxicology testing in cases of motor ve-
15 hicle crashes; and

16 (B) the reporting of alcohol and drug toxi-
17 cology results in cases of motor vehicle crashes.
