AMENDMENT intended to be proposed by Mr. SCHATZ (for
himself and Mr. MORAN)

Viz:

1 At the end of subtitle A of title III, add the following:

2 **SEC. 3120. EMERGENCY MEDICAL EQUIPMENT ON PAS-**

3 **SENGER AIRCRAFT.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 1 year after the
5 date of the enactment of this Act, the Administrator of
6 the Federal Aviation Administration shall evaluate and re-
7 vise, as appropriate, the regulations under part 121 of title
8 14, Code of Federal Regulations, regarding the emergency
9 medical equipment requirements, including the contents of

1 first-aid kits, applicable to all certificate holders operating
2 passenger aircraft under that part.

3 (b) CONSIDERATIONS.—In carrying out subsection
4 (a), the Administrator shall consider whether the min-
5 imum contents of approved emergency medical kits, in-
6 cluding approved first-aid kits, include appropriate medi-
7 cations and equipment to meet the emergency medical
8 needs of children.
