2 **SEC. 11. REPORT ON ALCOHOL DETECTION TECHNOLOGY.**

3 Not later than 90 days after the date of the enact-  
4 ment of this Act, the Secretary of Transportation shall  
5 submit a report to the Committee on Commerce, Science,  
6 and Transportation of the Senate and the Committee on  
7 Transportation and Infrastructure of the House of Rep-  
8 resentatives that—

9 (1) in addition to annual reports, describes the  
10 current status of the Driver Alcohol Detection Sys-

1       tem for Safety Program's alcohol detection tech-  
2       nology; and

3               (2) explains how such technology could poten-  
4       tially reduce alcohol-impaired driving if it is inte-  
5       grated into all newly manufactured motor vehicles.
