AMENDMENT intended to be proposed by Mr. DAINES

Viz:

1 At the end of subtitle F of title II, add the following:

2 **SEC. 2608. REPORT ON DESIGN AND IMPLEMENTATION OF**

3 **WIRELESS ROADSIDE INSPECTION SYSTEMS.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 180 days after the
5 date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Trans-
6 portation shall submit to the Committee on Commerce,
7 Science, and Transportation of the Senate and the Com-
8 mittee on Transportation and Infrastructure of the House
9 of Representatives a report regarding the design, develop-
10 ment, testing, and implementation of wireless roadside in-
11 spection systems.

1 (b) ELEMENTS.—The report required under sub-
2 section (a) shall include a determination as to whether
3 wireless roadside inspection systems—

4 (1) conflict with existing non-Federal electronic
5 screening systems, or creates capabilities already
6 available;

7 (2) require additional statutory authority to in-
8 corporate generated inspection data into the safety
9 measurement system or the safety fitness determina-
10 tions program; and

11 (3) provide appropriate restrictions to specifi-
12 cally address privacy concerns of affected motor car-
13 riers and operators.
