3 **SEC. ____ . ALASKA AVIATION SAFETY INITIATIVE.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Beginning on the date that is 1
5 year after the date of enactment of this section, and annually thereafter through fiscal year 2028, the Administrator
6 shall submit to the committees of relevant jurisdiction of
7 Congress a report on the FAA Alaska Aviation Safety Initiative (in this section referred to as the “FAASI”), including an itemized description of how the FAA budget

11 meets the goals of the FAASI.

1 (b) GAO STUDY ON ALASKA AVIATION SAFETY.—

2 (1) STUDY.—The Comptroller General shall
3 conduct a study to—

4 (A) examine the effectiveness of the
5 FAASI to improve aviation safety, service, and
6 infrastructure; and

7 (B) identify challenges within the FAA to
8 accomplishing safety improvements.

9 (2) REPORT.—Not later than 2 years after the
10 date on enactment of this section, the Comptroller
11 General shall submit to the committees of relevant
12 jurisdiction of Congress a report on the findings of
13 the study under paragraph (1), together with rec-
14 ommendations for such legislative or administrative
15 action as the Comptroller General deems appro-
16 priate.

17 (c) COMMITTEES OF RELEVANT JURISDICTION OF
18 CONGRESS DEFINITION.—In this section, the term “com-
19 mittees of relevant jurisdiction of Congress” means—

20 (1) the Committee on Commerce, Science, and
21 Transportation of the Senate;

22 (2) the Committee on Appropriations of the
23 Senate;

24 (3) the Committee on Transportation and In-
25 frastructure of the House of Representatives; and

- 1 (4) the Committee on Appropriations of the
- 2 House of Representatives.
