3 **SEC. \_\_\_\_ . INVESTIGATION OF COMPLAINTS.**

4 Section 41705(c) of title 49, United States Code, is  
5 amended by striking paragraph (1), and inserting the following:

7 “(1) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary shall—

8 “(A) not later than 120 days after the receipt of any complaint of a violation of this section or a regulation prescribed under this section, investigate such complaint; and

1           “(B) provide, in writing, to the individual  
2           that filed the complaint and the air carrier or  
3           foreign air carrier alleged to have violated this  
4           section or a regulation prescribed under this  
5           section, the determination of the Secretary with  
6           respect to—

8                     plaint; and  
9                     “(ii) any action the Secretary is tak-  
10                    ing in response to the complaint.”.
