4 BERS OR FORMER MEMBERS IN OBTAINING JOBS.—The  
5 corporation shall develop 1 or more policies that prohibit  
6 any individual who is an employee, contractor, or agent  
7 of the corporation from assisting a member or former

1 member in obtaining a new job (except the routine trans-  
2 mission of administrative and personnel files) if the indi-  
3 vidual knows that such member or former member violated  
4 the policies or procedures of the Center related to sexual  
5 misconduct or was convicted of a crime involving sexual  
6 misconduct with a minor in violation of applicable law.”.
