AMENDMENTS intended to be proposed by Mr. MARKEY

Viz:

1 On page 417, beginning on line 23, strike “the safe  
2 transportation of” and insert “an air carrier to trans-  
3 port”.

4 On page 418, strike line 10 and insert “ systems and  
5 that the carriage of hazardous materials complies with  
6 Hazardous Materials Regulations, including any changes  
7 to the Hazardous Materials Regulations adopted pursuant  
8 to this section;”.

9 On page 418, strike lines 11 through 15, and insert  
10 the following:

1           (3) the risk profile of the transportation of haz-  
2           ardous materials by unmanned aircraft systems, tak-  
3           ing into consideration the risk associated with dif-  
4           fering weights, quantities, and Packing Group classi-  
5           fications of hazardous materials; and

6           (4) mitigations to the risk of the hazardous ma-  
7           terials transported, including operational mitigations  
8           and aircraft-based mitigations.

9           (c) SAFETY RISK ASSESSMENTS.—The Secretary  
10          shall require unmanned aircraft operators to submit a  
11          safety risk assessment (SRA) acceptable by the Adminis-  
12          trator.

13          On page 418, line 16, strike “(c)” and insert “(d)”.

14          On page 418, beginning on line 20, strike “Such”  
15          and all that follows through line 22, and insert the fol-  
16          lowing: “Such changes shall be made concurrently with the  
17          authority in subsection (a).”.

18          On page 418, between lines 22 and 23, insert the fol-  
19          lowing:

20          (e) STAKEHOLDER INPUT ON CHANGES TO THE HAZ-  
21          ARDOUS MATERIALS REGULATIONS.—Within 180 days of  
22          the date of enactment of this section, the Secretary shall

- 1 hold a public meeting to obtain input on changes necessary
- 2 to implement this section within the Hazardous Materials
- 3 Regulations and to address any identified changes in risk.

- 4 On page 418, line 23, strike “(d)” and insert “(f)”.
